Secretary's Minutes

Financial Report

Jeanette Dubessa presented the financial report for June 6/20/2017 – 6/30/2017 beginning balance \$22,935.77, ending balance less committed funds \$2,746.99; and 7/1/17- 8/9/2017 beginning balance was \$6,201.67, ending balance less committed funds is -\$24,399.36. Alison Milobar motioned to approve the financial report for June 2017, Crisan Baker seconded. Motion carried.

- Check for 2016 yearbooks (\$24.49) reimbursement to Amanda Barnum, also has not been cashed. Will be voided and reissued to Amanda Barnum
- Discussion on whether to add Garden Club, Kinder Playday and Insurance (due in May) to funds committed. Decided to possibly break treasury report into 2 categories – one for constant, yearly unchanging expenses (like insurance), and one for other varying price and occurrence items (like Playday, Garden Club).
