Golden Empire's GATE Cluster Program Continues

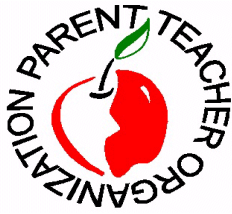


We have great news for Gifted and Talented (GATE) identified students who will be in grades 2-6 during the 2019-2020 school year. Golden Empire will

We need your help securing donations so we can make this event happen. We are asking for BBQ donations by grade level. Any quantities are appreciated!

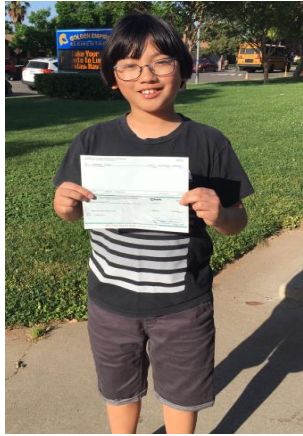
Kindergarten, 1st Grade, & 2nd Grade – \$2.00 or more for desserts

5th Grade GE Student Wins Poster Contest & \$\$\$!

This past April, as part of Mosquito Awareness Week, the Sacramento - Yolo Mosquito and Vector Control District announced the winners of



the 2019 annual "Fight the Bite" Contest for students in grades K-12. In an effort to teach children about the importance of mosquito prevention, the contest encouraged students to use art and submit a drawing that promotes the Fight the Bite theme to inspire everyone to prevent mosquitoes by practicing key messages such as draining standing water and using mosquito repellent. Students were divided into three grade categories: K-3, 4-6 and 7-12.

The winning entries were based on: creativity, originality and the ability to effectively communicate one or more of the District D's of Mosquito Prevention. Twelve winners were selected by a panel of judges.

We are proud to share that 5th grade student Thadeus Kim's artwork was chosen out of almost 1,500 entries the agency received as a winning entry! As a 2nd place winner, Thadeus won a check for \$100 and a \$200 check was awarded to the school and teacher, Mrs. Kurihara.
